Earn to Learn (closed for Fall of 2017, but open for Spring/Fall 2018) Scholarship for students interested in ASU, NAU, or UofA: earntolearn.org

This is a needs-based scholarship that teaches financial literacy; it rewards students that are saving money to attend ASU, NAU and UofA (they need to save \$500 before attending one of these schools and make deposits for at least 6 months) with \$4000 of matching scholarship funding. Students must save up to \$500 each year to remain eligible for ongoing funding for 4 years of college. DEADLINE for students starting Fall 2017 has passed. Pre-application only available for students starting in Spring 2018 or Fall 2018. Must be a US citizen or permanent resident. Must take free 3-hr financial literacy course after pre-application; then must take 10hrs of online financial literacy each year.

U of A Assurance Scholarship: Submit FAFSA and Admission application by March 1; if you meet eligibility requirements, U of A will invite you to fill out Resource Evaluation. Must get 3.0 unweighted GPA in first three years of your core classes. Family income below 42,000 and eligible for Pell Grant. If selected, you get \$2000 for 4 consecutive years plus \$7300 in housing for your Freshman year on-campus housing.

NAU Lumberjack scholarship: covers up to 100% of tuition (which is about \$9700 per year) but does not cover fees or other expenses. Requires 3.5 GPA in the 16 core college prep classes plus nothing lower than a B in any of them. Automatically considered for this upon admission; does not require separate application. Renewal possibility every year if maintain 3.0 overall GPA.

ASU Obama Scholarship: must be eligible for Pell; family must make under \$42,000. FAFSA and Admission application must be on file by Jan 1. 3.0 GPA in competency courses where A=4.0 (unweighted). This scholarship covers everything besides the expected family contribution (so estimated direct costs – EFC). Estimated direct costs include tuition and mandatory fees plus a standardized allowance for room/board and books/supplies. This scholarship is good for full four years of education.
