- 4. If you worked a lot during your high school years, what have you learned (leadership or managerial skills, for example) and how has that work contributed to your growth?
- 5. What are your career goals?
- 6. Are there any gaps or discrepancies in your academic record that you should explain (rising GPA, a bad year, etc)?
- 7. Have you overcome any unusual obstacles or hardships (for example, economic, familial, or physical) in your life?
- 8. If you did a lot of community service during you high school years, what have you learned and how has the service contributed to your growth?
- 9. Describe how you have demonstrated leadership ability both in and out of school.
- 10. Discuss a special attribute or accomplishment that sets you apart.
- 11. Describe your most meaningful achievements and how they relate to your field of study and your future goals.
- 12. How has your family background affected the way you see the world?
- 13. How has your education contributed to who you are today?
- 14. Why do you want to get a college education?
- 15. From a financial standpoint, what impact would this scholarship have on your education?
- 16. State any special personal or family circumstances affecting your need for financial assistance.
